MORECAMBE CORPORATION TRAMWAYS.

WHEREAS the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Morecambe (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") were authorised by the Morecambe Corporation Tramways Order, 1909 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order of 1909"), confirmed by the Tramways Order Confirmation Act, 1909, to construct and have constructed and opened for traffic the tramways in the said borough described in the schedule hereto and hereinafter referred to as "the abandoned tramways."

And whereas Parts II and III of the Tramways Act, 1870, are incorporated with the Order of 1909 and in the said Part III it is enacted by Section 41 inter alia as follows:—

"If at any time after the opening of any tramway in any district for traffic the pro-
