WITHERNSEA AND PATRINGTON DISTRICT ELECTRICITY.

NOTICE is hereby given that application has been made by Holderness Trust Limited whose registered office is situate at 2 and 3, Salisbury Court, Fleet Street, London, E.C. 4 (herein called "the Undertakers") to the Electricity Commissioners under the Electricity (Supply) Acts 1892 to 1926 for a Special Order for the following among other purposes (that is to say):—

1. To authorise the Undertakers to generate take transform supply sell and distribute electricity for all public and private purposes as defined by the above mentioned Acts within the following area (hereinafter referred to as the "area of supply") that is to say the Urban District of Withernsea and the Rural District of Patrington (other than and except the Parish of Paull) in the East Riding of the County of Yorks.

2. To authorise the Undertakers to exercise within the area of supply all the powers usually conferred on distributors of electrical energy.

3. The roadways level crossings over railways and bridge carrying roadway over drains not repairable by the Local Authority which may be broken up by the Undertakers in pursuance of the special powers granted by the Order are as follows:—

Waxholme Road (from the boundary), North Road, Arthur Street, Hull Road (from opposite Arthur Street to Queen Street), Queen Street and Hollym Road (to the boundary).

Rural District of Patrington.
