LEYTON.

Whereas the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Leyton (hereinafter called the Corporation), being the Urban Sanitary Authority for the said Borough, have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, partially to repeal, alter or amend the Leyton Urban District Council Act, 1904, so as:—

(1) To enable the Corporation to exercise with respect to surplus lands acquired under the Leyton Order, 1894, in connection with the widening of High Street and Holloway Road, Leyton, and under the Leyton Order, 1928, in connection with the widening and improvement of High Road, Leyton, High Road, Leytonstone, High Road and Cathall Road, Leytonstone, High Road and Church Lane, Leytonstone, and Mount Grove Road, Leytonstone, the following powers, namely:—

(a) to lay out and develop such surplus lands and to erect thereon and maintain houses, shops, offices, warehouses and other buildings and to sell lease exchange or otherwise dispose of such buildings;

(b) to grant building leases of any such lands or other easements rights or privileges in under or over such lands and to use or dispose of the building or other materials of any houses, shops, offices and premises on any of such lands acquired or appropriated by the Corporation which they may deem it necessary or desirable to pull down;

(c) to attach conditions or restrictions in the selling or disposing of such lands as to the use thereof and as to the buildings to be erected thereon and the use of such buildings;

(2) To enable the Corporation with the consent of the Minister of Health, to exercise similar powers with respect to surplus lands acquired under any Act or Order;

(3) To empower the Corporation to advance money to a purchaser or lessee of any of the surplus lands referred to in paragraph (1) above for the purpose of enabling him or assisting him to erect buildings on such land;

(4) To empower the Corporation, with the consent of the Minister of Health, to borrow moneys for the purposes aforesaid;

(5) For the several purposes of the Application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Act, or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875, and in force in the said borough as may be necessary or desirable:

And whereas it is proposed that a Provisional Order should be issued in compliance with the said Application;

Notice is hereby given that A. E. H. Goddard, Esq., one of the Inspectors of the Ministry of Health will attend at the Town Hall, Leyton, on Friday, the twenty-third day of November, 1928, at eleven o'clock in the forenoon, to hold a Local Inquiry into the subject-matter of the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.
