## MORLEY.

Whereas the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of the Borough of Morley (hereinafter called the Corporation), being the Urban Sanitary Authority for the said Borough, have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act,

1875, partially to repeal, alter or amend the Morley Corporation Act, 1923, so as:—

(1) To extend until the thirty-first day of December, 1934, the period allowed by Section 17 of the said Local Act for the completion of Work No. 4, authorised by the said Local Act which work consists of an aqueduct conduit or line or lines of pipes commencing in the urban district of Mytholmroyd at the valve chamber of the Withens Clough Reservoir thence passing through the urban districts of Sowerby and Luddenden Foot the parishes of Norland Upper Greetland and Clifton the urban districts of Greetland and Elland the borough of Brighouse and the urban districts of Spennborough and Birstall and terminating in the borough of Morley in the Birk Lane Service Reservoir of the Corporation;

(2) For the purposes of the Application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any alteration or amendment of the said Local Act, or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875, and in force in the said borough as may be necessary or desirable:

And whereas it is proposed that a Provisional Order should be issued in compliance with the said Application;

Notice is hereby given that G. H. Thiselton-Dyer, Esq., M.Inst.C.E., one of the Inspectors of the Ministry of Health will attend at the Town Hall, Morley, on Thursday, the thirteenth day of December, 1928, at half-past ten o'clock in the forenoon, to hold a Local Inquiry into the subject-matter of the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.

## BAILDON.

Whereas the Urban District Council of Baildon (hereinafter called the Council) have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, partially to repeal, alter or amend the Baildon Local Board Water Act, 1890, as amended by the Baildon Order, 1894, so as:—

(1) To empower the Council for the purposes of their water undertaking to acquire by agreement the lands known as Birch Close Farm situate in the Parish and Urban District of Bingley and containing in the whole an area of 128 acres 2 roods or thereabouts, together with the buildings thereon;

(2) To authorise the Council to construct works on the said farm as may be necessary for taking and utilising any waters to be found in or under the said lands;
