NENE AND WELLAND DISTRICT FISHERY ORDER, 1928.

#### ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 3RD JANUARY, 1929.)

#### FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1929.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

##### *Further Contraction of Salop Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area.*

1.—(1) The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1928 (No. 82) as amended by the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1928 (No. 83) shall be read and have effect as if the Area described in the First Schedule to this Order were substituted for the Infected Area described in the Schedule to the last mentioned Order.

(2) This Article shall come into operation on the eighth day of January, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.

##### *Further Contraction of Lancashire Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area.*

2.—(1) The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1928 (No. 81) as amended by the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1928 (No. 84) shall be read and have effect as if the Areas described in the Second and Third Schedules to this Order were substituted for the Infected Area described in the Schedule to the last mentioned Order.

(2) This Article shall come into operation on the eleventh day of January, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.

##### *Release of Infected Areas from Restrictions.*

3.—(1) The Area described in the First Schedule to this Order shall cease to be an Infected Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1925, as from the fourteenth day of January, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.

(2) The Area described in the Second Schedule to this Order shall cease to be an
