

'The District of Saint Edmund, Northampton':

"And whereas the said District of Saint Edmund, Northampton, has become a New Parish of the character contemplated by the Act of the 6th and 7th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 37, by the Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 104, and by the above-mentioned Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94:

"And whereas by the authority of another Order of Her said late Majesty in Council bearing date the 19th day of July, 1883, and published in the London Gazette on the 20th day of the same month, a District Chapelry was assigned to the Consecrated Church of Saint Michael and All Angels, situate in the said New Parish of Saint Edmund, Northampton, and the said District Chapelry was named 'The District Chapelry of Saint Michael and All Angels, Northampton':

"And whereas the said District Chapelry of Saint Michael and All Angels, Northampton, has, under the provisions of the above-mentioned Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 104, become a New Parish of the character contemplated by that Act and by the above mentioned Acts of the 6th and 7th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 37, and of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94:

"And whereas it has been represented to us and it appears to us to be expedient that the boundaries of the said New Parish of Saint Edmund, Northampton, and of the said New Parish of Saint Michael and All Angels, Northampton, should be altered in the manner which is hereinafter mentioned:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Claude Martin, Bishop of Peterborough (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme or Representation), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly represent, recommend and propose that, from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme or Representation and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order, the boundaries of the said New Parish of Saint Edmund, Northampton, and of the said New Parish of Saint Michael and All Angels, Northampton, shall be altered so that all those portions of the said New Parish of Saint Edmund, Northampton, and of the said New Parish of Saint Michael and All Angels, Northampton, which are described in the Schedule hereunder written and are delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto annexed and are thereon coloured pink, shall be dissevered from such New Parishes and shall be restored to and shall in future form part of the said Parish of Saint Giles, Northampton.

"And we further represent, recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing, recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts, or of any of them, or of any other Act of Parliament.

"THE SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference.

"The territory to be restored to the Parish of Saint Giles, Northampton, in the County of Northampton and in the Diocese of Peterborough, being:—

"I. All that portion of the New Parish of Saint Edmund, Northampton, in the said County and Diocese, which is bounded upon the north west by the New Parish of Saint Michael and All Angels, Northampton, in the said County and Diocese, upon the south west by the said Parish of Saint Giles, Northampton, upon the south by the extra parochial place known as the Priory of Saint Andrew, in the said County and Diocese, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the east and upon the north east, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said extra parochial place known as the Priory of Saint Andrew from the said New Parish of Saint Edmund, Northampton, at the junction of Billing Road with Victoria Road, and extending thence northward along the middle of Victoria Road for a distance of 16 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Wellingborough Road, and extending thence eastward along the middle of Wellingborough Road for a distance of 1½ chains or thereabouts to its junction with Raglan Street, and extending thence north westward along the middle of Raglan Street for a distance of 4 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Kettering Road upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Edmund, Northampton, from the said New Parish of Saint Michael and All Angels, Northampton.

"II. And also all that portion of the said New Parish of Saint Michael and All Angels, Northampton, which is bounded upon the north west partly by the New Parish of Saint Lawrence, Northampton, and partly by the Parish of Saint Sepulchre, Northampton, both in the said County and Diocese, upon the south west by the said Parish of Saint Giles, Northampton, upon the south east and upon the east by the said New Parish of Saint Edmund, Northampton, and upon the remaining side, that is to say, upon the north, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Edmund, Northampton, from the said New Parish of Saint Michael and All Angels, Northampton, at the junction of Kettering Road with Saint Michael's Road, and extending thence westward along the middle of Saint Michael's Road for a distance of 18 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Overstone Road upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Michael and All Angels, Northampton, from the said New Parish of Saint Lawrence, Northampton."

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme or Representation have been transmitted to the Patrons and to the Incumbents of the Cures affected by the arrangements which are contemplated by such Scheme or Representation and such Patrons and Incumbents have respectively signified their assent thereto:

And whereas the said Scheme or Representation has been approved on behalf of His Majesty at the Council held under the authority of the said Commission:
