

Rural District of Faversham.

- (81) Road from the Faversham—Shotten-and den road at Shepherd's Hill via Perry
(82) Wood, Stone Stile and Rhode Court Farm to its junction with the fork road north of the cross roads at South Street.

Rural District of Isle of Thanet.

- (92) Plumstone Road from the Birchington—Monkton road via St. Mildred's Church to its southern junction with the Birchington—Minster road at Acol.

Rural District of Malling.

- (83) Sandy Lane and Fartherwell Road, Ryarsh, from the Maidstone—Wrottingham county main road near Calais Court to the junction with the Teston—Offham district road near the third milestone from Teston.

Rural District of Sevenoaks.

- (84) Road commencing at Bowzell's Farm on the Sevenoaks—Weald road and terminating at the road between Winkhurst Green and Somerden Farm.
(85) Road leading from the Hildenborough—Edenbridge road (B. 2027) via Hale Oak to its junction with the Sevenoaks—Weald road at Brook Farm.

CAUTION WHEN APPROACHING
BRITISH PORTS.

PART I.

CLOSING OF PORTS.

Former Notice.—No. 1 of 1928; hereby cancelled.

(1) My Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, having taken into consideration the fact that it may be necessary to forbid all entrance to certain ports of the Empire, this is to give Notice that on approaching the shores of the British Isles, or any of the ports or localities of the British Empire, a sharp look-out should be kept for the signals described in the following paragraph, and for the vessels mentioned in paragraph (5), Part II., of this Notice, and the distinguishing and other signals made by them. In the event of such signals being displayed, the port or locality should be approached with great caution, as it may be apprehended that obstructions may exist.

(2) If entrance to a port is prohibited, three red lights vertically disposed by night, or three red balls vertically disposed by day, will be exhibited in some conspicuous position, in or near to its approach, which signals will also be shown by the vessels indicated in paragraph (5), Part II., of this Notice.
