

COUNTY OF SOUTHAMPTON.

THE CORONERS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1926.

ORDER FOR THE ALTERATION OF CORONERS' DISTRICTS.

Whereas by the Coroners (Amendment) Act, 1926, it is provided that the right of any person having power to appoint a franchise coroner shall cease on the next vacancy in the office which occurs after the passing of that Act and for all purposes relating to coroners the area in which the franchise coroner had jurisdiction shall thereupon, if and so far as it is not situated in a Borough the Council of which have power to appoint a Borough Coroner, be merged in the County.

And whereas on the 31st day of May, 1927, a vacancy in the office of franchise coroner for the Hundred of Christchurch and of the Liberty of Westover in the County of Southampton occurred:

And whereas the said County is divided into Coroners' Districts:

And whereas the Council of such County have submitted, after complying with the requirements of the Coroners (Orders as to Districts) Rules, 1927, to the Secretary of State a draft Order providing for the alteration of the existing Southampton Coroner's District of the County by the inclusion therein of the area which on the occurrence of the said vacancy merged in the County:

Now therefore, I, the Right Honourable Sir William Joynson-Hicks, Baronet, one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, hereby order that on and after the date hereof the division heretofore made of the County of Southampton into Coroners' districts shall be altered as follows, that is to say:

The Southampton Coroner's District shall comprise the Parishes and parts of Parishes mentioned in the Schedule to this Order.
