ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 18TH APRIL, 1929.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Application of Sheep Scab Order of 1928.

1. Part II (Restriction on Movement of Sheep out of a Movement Area) and Part III (Double Dipping of Sheep in a Double Dipping Area) of the Sheep Scab Order of 1928, hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order," are hereby applied to the Area described in the Schedule hereto, which shall be a Movement Area and a Double Dipping Area for the purposes of that Order.

Period Prescribed as Double Dipping Period.

2. The dates between which all sheep in the Area described in the Schedule hereto are to be dipped within the Area by the owner or person in charge of the sheep under and in accordance with Part III of the Principal Order are hereby fixed to be the thirty-first day of May and the first day of August, 1929.
