

To authorise the Undertaker to open and break up within the area of supply streets and parts of streets which are not repairable by the local authority.

To authorise the Undertaker to break up outside the area of supply the following roads:—

Parish of Haroldston St. Issels.

Mill Lane and the road to Merlins Bridge to the south of and nearly adjoining the Borough boundary.

To empower the Undertaker to construct, maintain, continue, work and use in over and upon the lands hereinafter described all necessary stations and works for the generation and supply of electrical energy together with all buildings, engines, apparatus, works and appliances necessary for the purposes of the Undertaking (that is to say):—

Lands within the area of supply:—

(a) A piece of land known as Cartlett Mill belonging or reputed to belong to the Undertaker situate in the Parish of Cartlett and lying between Mill Road and Cartlett and containing .159 of an acre or thereabouts.

(b) A piece of land known as Priory Mill belonging or reputed to belong to the Undertaker situate in the Parish of St. Thomas on the East side of the road to Haroldston Bridge and containing 1.933 acres or thereabouts.

Land outside the area of supply:—

(c) A piece of land known as Haroldston Mill belonging or reputed to belong to Stephen Jenkins situate in the Parish of Haroldston St. Issels in Mill Lane Merlins Bridge on the South of and nearly adjoining the Borough boundary and containing .108 of an acre or thereabouts.

To confer upon the Undertaker all or some of the powers of the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1926, and the enactments incorporated therewith, and to alter, vary or extinguish all rights and privileges which would or might interfere with any of the objects of the Order, and to confer all other rights and privileges necessary for carrying such objects into effect.

And notice is hereby given that copies of the draft Order and of an Ordnance Map showing the area of supply and the streets in which it is proposed that electric lines shall be laid down within a period to be specified by the Order, have been deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Pembroke at his office at Haverfordwest, with the Town Clerk of the Borough of the Town and County of Haverfordwest at his office at Haverfordwest and with the Clerk of the Rural District Council of Haverfordwest at his office at Haverfordwest.

Any authority company body or person desirous of bringing before the Electricity Commissioners any objection respecting the application must do so by letter sent by registered post addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Savoy Court, Strand, London, W.C. 2, and posted on or before the 20th May next, and a copy of any such objection must at the same time be forwarded to the Undertaker or his Parliamentary Agents or Solicitors.
