THE SOUTH YORKSHIRE MINES DRAINAGE SCHEME, 1929, MADE BY THE BOARD OF TRADE UNDER SECTION 18 OF THE MINING INDUSTRY ACT, 1920.

In pursuance of the provisions of the Mining Industry Act, 1920, notice is hereby given that the Board of Trade propose to make a scheme under Section 18 of the said Act with respect to the underground drainage of certain coal mines in the West Riding of the County of York.
