ORDER OF THE REGISTRAR GENERAL  
IN ENGLAND.

(Dated 27th May, 1929.)

Whereas under Section 21 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1874, the Registrar General, with the sanction of the Minister of Health, may from time to time alter Registration Sub-districts:—

Now, therefore, I, Sylvanus Percival Vivian, C.B., Registrar General of Births, Deaths, and Marriages in England, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Births and Deaths Registration Acts, 1836 to 1929, and with the sanction of the Minister of Health, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the South Molton Registration of Births, etc. (Alteration of Sub-districts) Order, 1929, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of June, 1929.

2. The existing South Molton Sub-district of South Molton Registration District shall

be extended by the addition of the Witheridge Sub-district of the same Registration District, and the extended Sub-district shall be known by the name of the South Molton Sub-district.

3. The Registrar of the existing South Molton Sub-district shall be the Registrar of that Sub-district as extended by this Order.
