#### BOROUGH OF WREXHAM.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1907.

#### HALIFAX CORPORATION ACT, 1915.

##### MOTOR OMNIBUS SERVICE.

**W**HEREAS by Section 15 of the Halifax Corporation Act, 1915, it is provided that the Corporation of Halifax (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") may, with the consent of the Board of Trade and the Local Authority and the Road Authority run omnibuses along any route outside the Borough;

And whereas the power of the Board of Trade to give such consent has been transferred to the Minister of Transport:

Notice is hereby given that, in pursuance of the said section the Corporation propose to make application to the Minister of Trans-

port for his consent to the running by them of motor omnibuses on the following route, that is to say:—

Commencing at the Borough Boundary at Station Road, Greetland, thence via Stainland Road, Rochdale Road, Long Wall, Jepson Lane, Victoria Road to a point at the junction of Victoria Road and Blackley Road at Hullen Edge, thence (1) via Blackley Road to a point near its junction with South Lane (2) via Hammerstone Leach Lane to a point near "The Brown Cow Inn" at Broad Carr, in the Urban District of Elland.

And notice is hereby further given that objection to the giving of such consent may be sent in writing to the Assistant Secretary, Roads Department, Ministry of Transport, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W. 1, on or before the 15th day of June, 1929.

A copy of any objection should at the same time be sent by the Objector to the Town Clerk, Town Hall, Halifax.
