WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant to the Incumbent for the time being of the Benefice of Old Radnor, in the Counties of Radnor and Hereford, and in the Diocese of Hereford, two yearly sums of sixty pounds, such yearly sums to be payable out of the Common Fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the first day of November in the year one thousand

nine hundred and twenty-eight and the first day of May in the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine respectively and to be receivable in four equal portions on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August and the first day of November in each and every year:

Provided always that the said yearly sums shall be and be taken to be in lieu of and in full substitution for the yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and twenty pounds heretofore payable by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England to the Incumbent of the said Benefice subject to certain conditions under the authority of another instrument sealed by us on the eighth day of November in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven and published in the London Gazette on the sixteenth day of the same month and year: Provided also that the yearly sum of sixty pounds secondly hereby granted or any part thereof shall be paid only in or towards discharging expenditure incurred in the remuneration of an assistant curate or other clergyman employed with the sanction of the Bishop to assist the Incumbent of Old Radnor in performing to the satisfaction of the Bishop the pastoral duties and services within that portion of the parish known as Kinnerton:

And provided lastly that the said yearly sum of sixty pounds secondly hereby granted shall continue payable as aforesaid so long only as may to us appear to be expedient under the circumstances from time to time affecting the said Benefice of Old Radnor.

In witness whereof we have hereunto set our common seal this thirteenth day of June in the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Rochdale Vicarage Act, 1866 (twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter eighty-six), and also in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter one hundred and eleven, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant out of the "Rochdale Vicarage Fund" created under the tenth section of the said Rochdale Vicarage Act, 1866, to the Incumbent of the Benefice of Facit, in the County of Lancaster and in the Diocese of Manchester, one yearly sum or stipend of eighty pounds such yearly sum or stipend to be calculated as from the fourth day of March in the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine and to be payable in equal quarterly portions on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August and the first day of November in each and every year: Provided always that the said yearly sum or stipend hereby granted shall terminate upon the cessation of the pension charged upon the revenues of the said Benefice of Facit under the provisions of the Incumbents Resignation Acts in favour of the Reverend Joseph Wilkinson.
