

BOROUGH OF WIMBLEDON.

BY an Order dated the sixth day of June, 1929, made under Section 77 of the Public Health Act, 1925, the Minister of Health has extended until the 1st day of June, 1931, the operation of the Wimbledon Private Street Works Order, 1927, which prescribed the rate of interest recoverable by the Council of the Borough of Wimbledon in respect of expenses for private street works incurred by the Council at 5½ per centum per annum instead of the rate of 5 per centum per annum prescribed by Section 77.

THE WOKING DISTRICT GAS (CHARGES) ORDER, 1921.

WELLINGTON (SALOP) GAS.

(Application for Special Order under Section 10 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920).

NOTICE is hereby given that the Wellington (Salop) Gas Company (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") whose principal office is at Market Street, Wellington, in the County of Salop, intend to apply to the Board of Trade for a Special Order under Section 10 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920, for all or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—

To authorise the transfer to the Company and the vesting in the Company of the undertaking of the Hadley Trench and Wrockwardine Wood Lighting Company Limited (hereinafter referred to as "the Limited Company") or such part thereof as may be defined by the Order and to empower the Company to carry on and maintain the undertaking of or business carried on by the Limited Company and to confirm any agreements for such transfer and to make any incidental provisions.

To prescribe the consideration for such transfer or vesting and to make provision as to the debts and liabilities of and moneys due or accrued due to the Limited Company.

To define and extend the limits within which the Company are authorised to supply gas, and to authorise them to supply gas within the following area (hereinafter referred to as "the new limits") that is to say:—

The parish of Preston-upon-the-Weald Moors in the rural district of Wellington.

So much of the parishes of Wrockwardine Eyton upon the Weald Moors and Hadley, in the said rural district as is not within the existing limits of supply and so much of the parish of Wellington rural in that district as is not within those limits except that part of the said parish which lies to the south of an imaginary straight line drawn through the School House at Lawley and Malins Lee Hall.

So much of the parish of Lilleshall in the rural district of Newport as lies to the south of the London Midland and Scottish Railway and to the west of an imaginary line drawn one hundred feet distant from and eastward of the road from St. Georges to Donnington between the boundary of the said parish and the point of junction of the said road with the main road from Wellington to Newport and thence continuing in a straight line to the said railway.

So much of the urban district of Oaken-gates as is not within the existing limits of supply.

So much of the urban district of Dawley as lies to the north of the imaginary straight line hereinbefore referred to and is not within the existing limits of supply.

So much of the borough of Wenlock as is comprised in the parish of Little Wenlock and is not within the existing limits of supply.

To authorise the Company to continue maintain and use any works belonging to or vested in them beyond their existing limits of supply.

To authorise the Company within the new limits to exercise all or any of the powers rights privileges and authorities with reference to the supply and distribution of gas and the opening and breaking up of streets and roads which are or may hereafter be exercisable by them within their existing limits of supply.

To authorise the Company to maintain erect and alter works for the storage of gas with all necessary machinery and apparatus connected therewith upon the lands hereinafter described. The said lands are:—

A piece of land situate at the Trench in the parish of Wombridge, in the urban district of Oaken-gates, in the County of Salop, containing by admeasurement two roods or thereabouts comprising part of the site of the Shropshire Iron Works and bounded on the north-west, north-east and south-east by those Works and on the south-west by the boundary between the said urban district and the parish of Hadley, in the rural district of Wellington.

To authorise reserve and other funds, to make provision as to the sale of shares or stock by auction or tender, to create and issue preference shares and stock and debenture stock (redeemable or irredeemable) and other securities.

To make provision as to the price to be charged for gas in the new limits, relief from
