RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

THE ROAD TRANSPORT LIGHTING ACT, 1927.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act that the Minister of Transport proposes after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by the Road Transport Lighting Act, 1927, to make Regulations to come into force not earlier than the first day of September, 1929, revoking the Road Vehicles Lighting Regulations, 1928 (S.R. & O., 1928, No. 286), and to substitute therefor new Regulations with respect to the carrying of lights by vehicles (other than railway locomotives, carriages and trucks and tramcars or trolley vehicles) when on any public highway or any other road to which the public has access.
