#### CANCELLATION OF A STANDING FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGES.

*By virtue of the Act 13 and 14 Victoria, chapter 7, intituled "An Act for Consolidating the Office of the Registrar of Metropolitan Public Carriages with the Office of Commissioners of Police of the Metropolis, and making other provisions in regard to the Consolidated Offices."*

I, the undersigned, Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby CANCEL the appointment of the following Standing for Hackney Carriages at the following place:—

CANCELLATION.

AT MARYLEBONE ROAD,  
YORK PLACE.

*In Three Portions.*

Seventeen Hackney Carriages:

*First Portion.* Seven carriages in Marylebone Road, commencing opposite the first lamp-post on South side, East of York Place, and extending Eastwards along centre of roadway.

Front of vehicles facing West.

*Second Portion.* One carriage in the centre of Marylebone Road, West of refuge opposite the Marylebone Casual Ward.

Front of vehicle facing West.

*Third Portion.* Nine carriages in Marylebone Road, commencing East of refuge opposite the entrance to Madame Tussaud's Exhibition, and extending Eastwards along centre of road, keeping clear of the gate to the Workhouse Master's Garden.

Front of vehicles facing West.

The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion, and the second portion by carriages from the third portion.
