FOREIGN HAY AND STRAW (AMEND-MENT) ORDER OF 1929 (No. 4).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 12TH AUGUST, 1929.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:---

Application of Order.

1. The provisions of Part II (Restriction on Movement of Sheep out of a Movement Area) of the Sheep Scab Order of 1928 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) as applied to the Area described in the Schedule to the Order of the Minister No. 4743, dated the 6th June, 1929, shall not apply to the movement of sheep of the Kerry Hill Breed to or from the special Sale specified in the Schedule to this Order, provided that the following conditions are complied with.

Special Conditions applicable to Sheep Moved to the Sale referred to in this Order.

2. All sheep exposed at the special Sale specified in the Schedule to this Order shall comply with the following conditions:--

(a) The sheep shall be accompanied by a Certificate of an Inspector of the Local Authority of the district from which the sheep are moved to the effect:—

(i) that the sheep have within 56 days before the movement been double-dipped

Withdrawal of Prohibition of Landing of Hay and Straw from Sweden.

1. The Foreign Hay and Straw Order of 1912 shall be read and have effect as if Sweden were included in the Schedule (*Countries from* which Importation is not Prohibited) to that Order, and the Foreign Hay and Straw (Amendment) Order of 1929 (No. 3) shall cease to operate accordingly.

Commencement and Short Title.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the fourteenth day of August, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, and may be cited as the Foreign Hay and Straw (Amendment) Order of 1929 (No. 4).

(ii) that the sheep, since the second dipping, have been kept isolated from sheep which have not been so dipped, and have not been exposed in any market, fairground or saleyard.

(b) Such Certificate shall on the arrival of the sheep at the said special Sale, be delivered up to the Inspector of the Ministry.

(c) The sheep may be moved from the said special Sale only if accompanied by a licence granted by an Inspector of the Ministry authorising movement of the sheep to any destination in Great Britain and subject to such conditions, if any, as may be specified in the licence.

 (\vec{a}) All sheep exposed at the said special Sale shall be kept separate from all other sheep during movement to and from the Sale and whilst being exposed thereat.

Interpretation.

3. The expression "douple-dipped" in this Order has the same meaning as in the principal Order.
