TRADE BOARDS ACTS, 1909 AND 1918.

BOOT AND SHOE REPAIRING TRADE BOARD (GREAT BRITAIN).

PROPOSAL TO VARY MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES FOR CERTAIN CLASSES OF MALE AND FEMALE WORKERS.

In accordance with Regulations made under Section 18 of the Trade Boards Act, 1909, by the Minister of Labour and dated 21st April, 1927, the Boot and Shoe Repairing Trade Board (Great Britain) HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they PROPOSE TO VARY the General Minimum Time Rates and Overtime Rates for certain classes of male and female workers, including male and female apprentices and learners.

Particulars of the proposed variation may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Trade Board.

In accordance with Section 3 (5) of the Trade Boards Act, 1918, the Trade Board will consider any Objections to the above Proposal to Vary, which may be lodged with them within two months from the 16th August, 1929. Such Objections should be in writing and signed by the person making the same (adding his or her full name and address), and should be sent to the Secretary, Boot and Shoe Repairing Trade Board (Great Britain), 1, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W. 1. It is desirable that Objections should state precisely and, so far as possible, with reasons what is objected to.

MERCHANDISE MARKS ACT, 1926.

With reference to the notices which were published in certain issues of the London Edinburgh and Belfast Gazettes regarding references made by the Board of Trade to the Standing Committee under the Merchandise Marks Act, 1926, namely:—

(1) in the issue of the said Gazettes of the 4th May, 1928, in respect of the following classes and descriptions of imported goods—
