(c) The Minister has consented to the adoption by the Council of section 21 (prevention of water flowing on footpath), section 22 (preventing soil, etc. from being washed into streets), section 44 (offensive trades), and the sections contained in Part V (watercourses, streams, etc.) of the Public Health Act, 1925, to take effect on the 26th day of August, 1929.

BY an Order dated the eighth day of August, 1929, the Minister of Health (1) has declared that, on and after the twentysixth day of August, 1929, Sections 17, 18, 19, 20, 22, 23, 24, 26, 28, 29, 30, 32 and 33, comprised in Part II, and Part X of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, shall be in force in the Urban District of Formby subject. however, as regards Sections 23, 30 and 92, to the conditions mentioned in the Order; and (2) has repealed Sections 22, 25 and 26 of the Formby Urban District Council Act, 1905.
