

to 1928 within the parishes of Beddingham, Chailey Detached, East Chiltington, Glynde, Hamsey, Plumpton, Ringmer, Southover Without, South Malling Without, St. John Without, St. Ann Without, Streat, West Fittleham and Westmeston in the Rural District of Chailey, so much of the parish of Ditchling in the said Rural District as lies outside the circumference of a circle drawn with the west entrance gate of St. John's Churchyard in the urban district of Burgess Hill as centre and a radius of one and a half miles and the parishes of Alceston, Alfriston, Berwick, East Dean, Folkington, Friston, Jevington, Litlington, Lullington, Selmeaton, West Dean and Wilmington in the Rural District of Eastbourne, all in the County of East Sussex (hereinafter referred to as "the area of supply").

To authorise the Undertakers to exercise within the area of supply all powers usually conferred on distributors of electricity.

To authorise the Undertakers to break up certain streets and parts of streets not repairable by the local authority and railways within the area of supply.

To make provision as to the maximum prices which may be charged by the Undertakers for electricity within the area of supply.

To make provision for the transfer of the undertaking in the manner upon the terms and within the period prescribed by the Order.

And notice is hereby also given that any authority, company, body or person desirous of

bringing before the Electricity Commissioners any objections respecting the application must do so by registered letter addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Savoy Court, Strand, W.C. 2, and despatched on or before the 30th day of September 1929, and a copy of such objections must also be forwarded to the undermentioned Solicitors or Parliamentary Agents.
