tioned Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94:

"And whereas by the authority of an Order of Her said late Majesty in Council bearing date the 10th day of August, 1888, and published in the London Gazette on the 14th day of the same month a Consolidated Chapelry was assigned to the consecrated Church of Saint James situate at Gunnersbury in the said New Parish of (Saint George) Old Brentford, and the said Consolidated Chapelry was named 'The Consolidated Chapelry of Saint James, Gunnersbury':

"And whereas by the authority of another Order of Her said late Majesty in Council bearing date the 6th day of April, 1889, and published in the London Gazette on the 12th day of the same month, a Consolidated Chapelry was assigned to the consecrated Church of Saint Alban the Martyr, situate at Acton Green in the New Parish of All Saints, South Acton, in the said County and Diocese and the said Consolidated Chapelry was named 'The Consolidated Chapelry of Saint Alban the Martyr, Acton Green ':

"And whereas the said Consolidated Chapelry of Saint James, Gunnersbury, and the said Consolidated Chapelry of Saint Alban the Martyr, Acton Green, have under the provisions of the above mentioned Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 37, become New Parishes of the character contemplated by that Act, by the above mentioned Act of the 6th and 7th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 37, and by the above mentioned Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94:

"And whereas it has been represented to us, and it appears to us to be expedient that the boundaries of the said New Parish of (Saint George) Old Brentford, the said New Parish of Saint James, Gunnersbury, and the said New Parish of Saint Alban the Martyr, Acton Green, should be altered in the manner which is hereinafter mentioned:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Honourable and Right Reverend Arthur Foley, Bishop of London (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme or Representation), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly represent, recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme or Representation and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the boundaries of the said New Parish of (Saint George) Old Brentford, the said New Parish of Saint James, Gunnersbury, and the said New Parish of Saint Alban the Martyr, Acton Green, shall be altered so that (first) all those contiguous portions of the said New Parish of (Saint George) Old Brentford and of the said Parish of Ealing which are described in the First Schedule hereunder written and are delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto annexed and are thereon coloured pink shall be dissevered from such New Parish and Parish respectively and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Saint James, Gunnersbury, and (secondly) all that portion of the said New

Parish of (Saint George) Old Brentford which is described in the Second Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the said map or plan hereunto annexed and is thereon coloured green shall be dissevered from such New Parish and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Saint Alban the Martyr, Acton Green.

"And we further represent, recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing, recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts, or of any of them, or of any other Act of Parliament.

"THE SCHEDULES to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference.

"The First Schedule.

"The territory to be annexed to the New Parish of Saint James, Gunnersbury, in the County of Middlesex and in the Diocese of London, being:-

"I. All that portion of the New Parish of (Saint George) Old Brentford, in the said County and Diocese, which is bounded upon the north east by the Parish of Ealing, in the said County and Diocese, upon the south east by the said New Parish of Saint James, Gunnersbury, and upon the remaining side, that is to say, upon the west, by an imaginary line, commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint James, Gunnersbury, from the said New Parish of (Saint George) Old Brentford, at the centre of the bridge which carries the North and South Western Junction Railway across Gunnersbury Lane, and extending thence first northward and then north westward along the middle of Gunnersbury Lane, for a distance of 37 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said New Parish of (Saint George) Old Brentford from the said Parish of Ealing.

"II. And also all that contiguous portion of the said Parish of Ealing which is bounded upon the south west partly by the above described portion of the said New Parish of (Saint George) Old Brentford and partly by the said New Parish of Saint James, Gunnersbury, upon the east by the New Parish of Saint Alban the Martyr, Acton Green, upon the north east by the New Parish of All Saints, South Acton, upon part of the north west by the Consolidated Chapelry of Saint Martin, West Acton, all in the said County and Diocese, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the remaining part of the north west and upon the west, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said Consolidated Chapelry of Saint Martin, West Acton, from the said Parish of Ealing, at the centre of the bridge which carries Gunnersbury Lane across the Ealing Extension Line of the Metropolitan District Railway, and extending thence first south westward and then south eastward along the middle of Gunnersbury Lane for a distance of 24 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said Parish of Ealing from the said New Parish of (Saint George) Old Brentford.
