

1. To make provision in regard to the application of the gas revenue of the Council, the formation of a new reserve fund and the inclusion therein of the moneys standing to the credit of the existing reserve fund of their gas undertaking or otherwise the appropriation of surplus profits in connection with their gas undertaking the charging of deficiencies in respect of their gas undertaking and the payment to the general rate fund of any balance of the receipts of the Council in connection with their gas undertaking and the payment of expenses in connection therewith.

2. To increase the maximum price now authorised for gas supplied by the Council and to make provision with reference to the prices which may be charged by the Council.

3. To repeal alter or amend some of the provisions of the Barry and Cadoxton Local Board (Gas and Water) Act 1893, and of the Barry Urban District Council Act, 1913, and any other Act or Order of the Council so far as the same relate to the matters aforesaid.

Any local or other public authority company or person desiring to bring before the Board of Trade any objection to the draft Order may do so by registered letter addressed to the

Director of Gas Administration, Board of Trade, Great George Street, London, S.W. 1, and despatched on or before the twenty-first day of October, 1929.

Any such objection shall state (a) the specific grounds of objection and (b) the omissions additions or modifications asked for.

A copy of the objection must be forwarded to the Clerk to the Council or to the undersigned Parliamentary Agents at the same time as it is sent to the Board of Trade.

A copy of the draft Order has been deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Glamorgan, at his office at Cardiff and at the offices of the Council at Barry.

Printed copies of the draft Order may be obtained at the price of one shilling each at the offices of the Council and at the offices of the undersigned Parliamentary Agents.
