

subject to reservations restrictions and conditions; Agreements with owners &c. of lands for securing the purity of water &c.

Breaking up of roads streets &c. for purposes of laying maintaining &c. mains pipes apparatus &c. for purposes of new and acquired works and distribution of water &c.

Powers and provisions for preservation and protection of the intended Newnham Pumping Station (Work No. 10) and the intended Adit (Work No. 11) and the waters to be obtained therefrom from and against contamination and pollution; Prohibition prevention and remedying of and imposition of conditions obligations and restrictions with respect to the escape from any sink sewer cesspool drain manure-heap or dunghill of any substance or liquid of a character involving or likely to involve the pollution or contamination of water into the subsoil of any lands within an area (in which the said intended Works will be situated) comprising parts of the parishes of Buckland (detached) Norton, Ospringe and Stone in the said Rural District of Faversham; Powers to Company to execute works &c. and other provisions affecting such lands &c. in that area and elsewhere; Power to Company to make Byelaws and regulations with respect to foregoing matters to be in force in the said area and elsewhere and powers of entry upon lands and premises for purposes of inspection and execution of works &c. and the imposition and recovery of penalties with respect to such matters.

Increase alteration repeal and re-enactment with or without modification of existing, and new and additional, rates rents and charges for supply of water and alteration of existing basis upon which same charged, including existing high level charges; Special provisions as to charges for baths above a certain capacity and/or provided with emptying apertures and as to same being treated and charged for as fixed baths; Alteration of quarterly dates for payment of water rates; date of coming into force of new or altered charges etc; revision of rates and charges and alteration of existing provisions relative thereto; amendment or repeal of section 6 of Mid Kent Water Order 1920 and of enactments referred to therein.

Rates to be payable by owners instead of occupiers in certain cases; Supply of water by meter only to certain classes of premises, hose-pipes and refrigerating apparatus or if used for washing horses carriages and motor cars and charges for such supplies; Assessment of and charges payable for houses or buildings connected by any means of communication other than a public highway; Requirement of minimum capacity for cisterns at high levels; Extension of hours of entry for purposes of inspection; provisions as to maximum pressure in certain cases.

Additional capital and borrowing powers; redeemable securities; Issue and disposal of stock and other securities; application of funds and revenues; dividends; reserve funds; byelaws penalties etc and other financial and administrative provisions.

Agreements with and powers to local and other authorities companies bodies and persons with respect to any of the matters aforesaid and any purposes of or incidental to the intended Act and confirmation thereof.

Incorporation Repeal and amendments of Acts &c.

Duplicate plans and sections showing the lines situations and levels of the works to be authorised by the intended Act the plans showing also the lands intended to be taken or used compulsorily under the powers of the Bill and a book of reference to such plans containing the names of the owners and lessees or reputed owners and lessees and of the occupiers of such lands will on or before the 30th day of November instant be deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Kent at his office at the Sessions House Maidstone and on or before the same day copies of so much of the said plans sections and book of reference as relate to each of the areas hereinafter mentioned will be deposited for public inspection as follows (that is to say):—

So far as relates to the Urban District of Wrotham with the Clerk to the District Council of that Urban District at his office;

So far as relates to the Rural Districts of Hollingbourne, Faversham, Malling and West Ashford with the Clerks to the District Councils of those respective districts at their respective offices;

So far as relates to the parishes of Harrietsham, Dunkirk, Lenham, Charing, Ospringe, Newnham, Eastling, Doddington, Thornham (or Thurnham), Hollingbourne, Stansted, Leybourne and Mereworth with the respective Clerks to the Parish Councils of those respective parishes at their respective offices or if any such Clerk has no office at his residence, or if there is no Clerk with the Chairman of the Parish Council at his residence and so far as relates to the parishes of Otterden, Norton, Trottscliffe, and Addington with the respective Chairmen of the Parish Meetings of those parishes at their respective residences.

Printed copies of the Bill for the intended Act will be deposited in the Committee and Private Bill Office of the House of Commons on or before the 17th day of December next. On and after the 21st day of December next a copy of the Bill may be inspected and copies obtained at the price of four shillings each at the offices of the undermentioned Parliamentary Agents.

A notice stating the objects of the intended Act has been or will be published in full in the Kent Messenger of the 16th and 23rd November instant.
