The Minister of Transport proposes to confirm the Order and gives notice that any person affected who may be desirous of objecting to the confirmation of the same must in accordance with the Electricity (Confirmation of Special Order) Rules, 1921, do so by memorial addressed to the Minister of Transport written on one side only of foolscap paper and sent by registered post addressed to The Secretary, Ministry of Transport, 6, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W. 1, and posted not later than the 24th day of January, 1930. A copy of any such memorial must also be sent in like manner to Alfred Dickinson, Esq., 2, Railway Road, Ormskirk, Solicitor, or to Messrs. Lees and Company, Palace Chambers, Bridge Street, Westminster, London, S.W. 1, Parliamentary Agents for the Order. Such memorial must be sealed or signed by the person objecting or by some responsible and duly authorised person on his behalf, and must state the specific grounds of objection to the Order and the modifications desired.

A copy of the Order as submitted for confirmation has been deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the County Palatine of Lancaster at his office at Preston and with the Clerk to the Rural District Council of West Lancashire at his office.

Copies of the Order as submitted for confirmation may be obtained at a price not exceeding two shillings each from Mr. Hugh Dawson, Rating Office, Gravel Lane, Banks, near Southport and at the offices of the before-mentioned Parliamentary Agents.

HALIFAX CORPORATION ACT, 1915.

MOTOR OMNIBUS SERVICE.

WHEREAS by Section 15 of The Halifax Corporation Act, 1915, it is provided that the Corporation of Halifax (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") may, with the consent of the Board of Trade and the Local Authority and the Road Authority run omnibuses along any route outside the Borough;

And whereas the power of the Board of Trade to give such consent has been transferred to the Minister of Transport;

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of the said Section the Corporation propose to make application to the Minister of Transport for his consent to the running by them of motor omnibuses on the following route, that is to say:—

In the Parish and Urban District of Stainland, commencing in Stainland Road at the Black Horse Inn, thence in a Southerly direction towards Sowood Green along Broadgate, Green Lane, Claypit Lane and New Road, terminating at the junction of New Road and New Hey Road at Outlane in the said Parish and Urban District of Stainland.

And notice is hereby further given that objection to the giving of such consent may be sent in writing to the Assistant Secretary, Roads Department, Ministry of Transport, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W. 1, on or before the 11th day of January, 1930.

A copy of any objection should at the same time be sent by the Objector to the Town Clerk, Town Hall, Halifax.
