<sup>1.</sup> Inverness.—An Area comprising the islands known as the Outer Hebrides (except the Islands of St. Kilda, Dune, Soay and in the county of Inverness.

2. Ross and Cromarty.—An Area comprising the islands of Lewis, including the smaller islands adjacent thereto, in the county of Ross and Cromarty.
