GAS REGULATION ACT, 1920.

Notice of Application by the Town Council of Redcar for a Special Order under Section 10 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Town Council of Redcar have applied to the Board of Trade for a special order under the provisions of Section 10 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920:—

(1) To extend the borrowing powers of the Council as gas undertakers for the Borough of Redcar, the Urban District of Saltburn-by-the-Sea, and the Parishes of Marske-by-the-Sea and Kirkleatham in the Rural District of Guisborough.

(2) To confer upon the Council in respect of their gas undertaking additional powers affecting repairs in case of danger; the supply of gas where a consumer has a separate supply; the mode of cutting off supplies; the expenses of reconnecting discontinued supplies; the removal of fittings where a supply of gas is discontinued; the recovery of several sums in one summons; receipts in the case of persons not sui juris; returns to the Minister of Health with respect to the repayment of debt; and the application of certain provisions of the Redcar Urban District Council Gas Act, 1920.

Copies of the Draft Order are deposited for public inspection free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, Redcar; at the office of the Clerk of the Peace, County Hall, Northallerton; at the office of the Clerk to the Urban District Council, Saltburn-by-the-Sea; and at the office of the Clerk to the Rural District Council, Guisborough; and copies may be purchased from the Town Clerk's Office, Redcar, at a price of one shilling each.

Any local or other public authority company or person desiring to bring before the Board of Trade any objection to the Draft Order may do so by registered letter addressed to the Director of Gas Administration, Board of Trade, Great George Street, London, S.W. 1, and despatched on or before March 6th, 1930. Any such objection should state the specific grounds of objection and the omissions additions or modifications asked for, and a copy of the objection must at the same time be sent to the undersigned.

LATHOM AND BURSCOUGH SKELMERSDALE AND DISTRICT ELECTRICITY SPECIAL ORDER, 1930.

APPLICATION has been made by the Lancashire Electric Power Company of 196, Deansgate, Manchester, in the County of Lancaster (hereinafter referred to as "the Applicants") to the Electricity Commissioners under the Electricity (Supply) Acts 1882 to 1928, for a Special Order for the following objects:—

1. To authorise the Applicants to supply and distribute electricity for all public and private purposes within the following area (hereinafter referred to as "the area of supply"), that is to say:—

The urban districts of Lathom and Burscough and Skelmersdale, so much of the rural district of Wigan as comprises the parishes of Dalton, Parbold and so much of the parish of Wrightington as lies to the west of an imaginary line commencing at a point on the boundary between the said parish and the urban district of Upholland, 100 yards west of the point at which the western boundary of Appley Lane crosses such first-mentioned boundary and proceeding in a northerly direction parallel to and at a distance of 100 yards west of the western boundary of Appley Lane and of the western boundary of Robin Hood Lane to a point 100 yards north of the northerly boundary of Hall Lane and continuing in an easterly direction parallel to and at a distance of 100 yards north of Hall Lane and Crow Orchard Road to the point at which such imaginary line intersects the boundary between the said parish of Wrightington and the township of Shevington, and the parish of Bickerstaffe and the township of Bispham in the rural district of West Lancashire.

2. To authorise the Applicants to exercise within the area of supply all powers usually conferred on distributors of electricity.

3. To authorise the Applicants to break up streets not repairable by the local authority and railways within the area of supply.

4. A printed copy of the draft Order and Maps showing the proposed area of supply and the streets and parts of streets in which it is proposed that electric lines shall be laid down within a specified time have been deposited for public inspection at the office of the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Lancaster at Preston; the Clerk to the Lathom and Burscough Urban District Council at Ormskirk; the Clerk to the Skelmersdale Urban District Council at Ormskirk; the Clerk to the Wigan Rural District Council at Wigan and the Clerk to the West Lancashire Rural District Council at Ormskirk.
