## SECTION 7.

*Revocation of Certificates of Naturalization.*

The Secretary of State has revoked the following Certificates:—

Ephraim Pugachow (and his Wife, Rosa Pugachow); Certificate No. A 15,786; Granted, 22nd February, 1928; Revoked, 13th January, 1930. Reason: Sentenced within 5 years of grant to a fine of not less than one hundred pounds. (S.7 (2) (b)).
