

At the Court at *Buckingham Palace*, the 15th day of *May*, 1930.

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the 7th and 8th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 94, of the Act of the 13th and 14th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, and of the Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, duly prepared, and laid before His Majesty in Council, a Scheme or Representation, bearing date the 8th day of May, 1930, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

“We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting under the provisions of the Act of the 7th and 8th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 94, of the Act of the 13th and 14th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, and of the Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty,

Chapter 94, have prepared, and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Scheme or Representation for altering the boundaries of the New Parish of Saint Peter, South End, Croydon, of the New Parish of Christ Church, Broad Green, Croydon, of the New Parish of Saint Andrew, Croydon, of the New Parish of Saint Matthew, Croydon, of the New Parish of Saint Michael and All Angels, Croydon, and of the New Parish of Saint Mary Magdalene, Addiscombe, all in the County of Surrey and in the Diocese of Canterbury:

“Whereas District Chapelries have been assigned to each of the Churches of Saint Peter, South End, Croydon; Christ Church, Broad Green, Croydon; Saint Matthew, Croydon; and Saint Mary Magdalene, Addiscombe, and a Consolidated Chapelry has been assigned to the Church of Saint Andrew, Croydon, and a separate District for spiritual purposes has been constituted by the name of Saint Michael and All Angels, Croydon, by the Orders in Council, the dates of which are stated in the 3rd Column of the following Table:—

“And whereas the District Chapelries, the Consolidated Chapelry, and the District named in the foregoing Table have become New Parishes of the character contemplated by the Act of the 6th and 7th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 37, by the Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 104, and by the above mentioned Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94:

“And whereas it has been represented to us and it appears to us to be expedient that the boundaries of the said New Parishes should be altered in the manner which is hereinafter mentioned:

“Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Honourable and Most Reverend Cosmo Gordon, Archbishop of Canterbury (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme or Representation), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly represent recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme or Representation and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the boundaries of the said New Parish of Saint Peter, South End, Croydon, of the said New Parish of Christ Church, Broad Green, Croydon, of the said New Parish of Saint Andrew, Croydon, of the said New Parish of Saint

Matthew, Croydon, of the said New Parish of Saint Michael and All Angels, Croydon, and of the said New Parish of Saint Mary Magdalene, Addiscombe, shall be altered so that (first) all those portions of the said New Parish of Saint Peter, South End, Croydon, and of the said New Parish of Saint Andrew, Croydon, which are described in the First Schedule hereunder written and are delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto annexed and are thereon coloured pink shall be dissevered from such New Parishes and shall be restored to and shall in future form part of the Parish of Croydon, in the said County of Surrey and in the said Diocese of Canterbury; (secondly) all that portion of the said Parish of Croydon which is described in the Second Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the said map or plan hereunto annexed and is thereon coloured green shall be dissevered from such Parish and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Saint Andrew, Croydon; (thirdly) all that portion of the said Parish of Croydon which is described in the Third Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the said map or plan hereunto annexed and is thereon coloured blue shall be dissevered from such Parish and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Saint Michael and All Angels, Croydon;
