

north east corner of the enclosure numbered 23 on the said map thence following generally in a westerly and northerly direction along the boundary between the said borough and the said parish or township of Wentworth to a point sixteen yards measured in a southerly direction from the north east corner of the enclosure numbered 433 on the said map thence crossing Barnsley road to the point of commencement of the said imaginary line.

The area so proposed to be added to the area of supply as defined in the Principal Order is hereinafter referred to as "the added area."

To authorise the Company to exercise within the added area all powers usually conferred upon distributors of electricity and to extend and make applicable to the added area all or some of the provisions of the Principal Order.

To repeal so much of the Rotherham Corporation Electric Lighting Order 1898 as relates to the added area and to alter vary or extinguish all rights and privileges which would or might interfere with the objects of the intended Order and to confer other powers and privileges necessary for carrying such objects into effect.

And notice is hereby also given that any authority company body or person desirous of bringing before the Electricity Commissioners any objections respecting the application must do so by registered letter addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Savoy Court, Strand, W.C. 2, and despatched on or before the 31st day of July 1930 and a copy of such objections must also be forwarded to the undermentioned Parliamentary Agents.

#### NEWPORT CORPORATION ACT, 1925.

**W**HEREAS by Section 38 of the Newport Corporation Act, 1925, it is provided that the Corporation of Newport may, with the consent of the Minister of Transport and the Local Authority of the district, run omnibuses along any route outside the Borough. Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of the said Section the Corporation of Newport have made application to the Minister of Transport for his consent to the running by them of omnibuses on the following routes, that is to say:—

From the boundary of the County Borough of Newport on the main road leading from Newport to Chepstow to the Royal Oak Inn, Chepstow Road, in the parish of Christchurch.
