Three Hackney Carriages.

On South-west side of Centre Roadway, commencing at a point 8 yards from the junction with South Eaton Place, extending North-eastward, by kerb, as far as necessary for three carriages.

APPOINTMENTS OF STANDINGS FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGES WITHIN THE
METROPOLITAN POLICE DISTRICT, AND REGULATIONS TO BE OBSERVED.

By virtue of the Act 13 and 14 Victoria, chapter 7, intituled "An Act for Consolidating the Office of the Registrar of Metropolitan Public Carriages with the Office of Commissioners of Police of the Metropolis, and making other provisions in regard to the Consolidated Offices."

I, the undersigned, Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby APPOINT Standings for Hackney Carriages at the following places, and do make the following Regulations with regard to the Boundaries for the same, viz. :—

31st May, 1930.

APPOINTMENTS.

AT TURNHAM GREEN TERRACE
AND WOODSTOCK ROAD,
BEDFORD PARK.

In two portions.

Nine Hackney Carriages.

First Portion.—Two carriages on the West side of Turnham Green Terrace, commencing at a point ten yards North of the Cabmen's Shelter (opposite the entrance to Turnham Green Railway Station) and extending Northward, by kerb, as far as necessary for two carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the South.

Second Portion.—Seven carriages on the East side of Woodstock Road, commencing at a point five yards South of first gully grate (approximately twenty-one yards North of the Northern kerb line of Bath Road) and extending Northward, by kerb, as far as necessary for seven carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the South.

The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.

12th June, 1930.

AT SUSSEX GARDENS, West-
BOURNE TERRACE, W.

In two portions.

Twelve Hackney Carriages.

First Portion.—Six carriages on the West side of garden enclosure, East side of roadway (opposite St James's Church); three carriages to stand each side of the Cabmen's Shelter, the bonnet of the first carriage to be in line with the first tree from the South-west corner of Sussex Gardens.

Front of vehicles toward the South.

Second portion.—Six carriages on the North side of garden enclosure, South side of roadway, commencing at a point opposite the doorway of No. 48, Sussex Gardens, and extending Eastward, by kerb, as far as necessary for six carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the West.

The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.

12th June, 1930.

AT PARK LANE, W.

Three Hackney Carriages:

On the West side of roadway, commencing at a point in line with the Cattle Trough (opposite Hertford Street) and extending Southward, by kerb, as far as necessary for three carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the North.
