The following Statute made by the Governing Body of Magdalene College, in the University of Cambridge, on the 21st day of June, 1930, has been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923."

STATUTE to alter and amend the Statutes of the College of St. Mary Magdalene commonly called Magdalene College in the University of Cambridge, which amending Statute having been duly made at a General Meeting of the Governing Body of the said College specially summoned for this purpose and held on the 19th day of May, 1930 (notice of the proposed amending Statute having been given to the said University) and passed at such meeting by the votes of all persons present and voting is now submitted for the approval of His Majesty the King in Council.

WE, The Master and Fellows of Magdalene College in the University of Cambridge do hereby in pursuance of the power given to us by the 7th Section of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923, alter and amend the Statutes made under that Act in

relation to our said College in manner following, that is to say:—

By repealing Paragraph 6 of Statute XXXI intituled The Governing Body and substituting therefor the following Paragraph to form an amended Paragraph 6 of the same Statute:—

"6. Notwithstanding any provision contained in these Statutes no Member of the Governing Body in statu pupillari shall be entitled to vote upon any College business other than the alteration of Statutes till the expiration of one year from the date of his election to his Fellowship and no Member of the Governing Body shall be entitled to vote upon any College business other than the alteration of Statutes unless he has attended at least one half of the meetings of the Governing Body to which he was duly summoned in the academical year last ended save that meetings held while a member of the Governing Body has leave of absence shall not be counted as meetings to which he was duly summoned and save that the Governing Body may by the votes of not less than two-thirds of their number sanction the absence of any member from one or more meetings when such absence is due to sickness or other urgent cause and such meeting or meetings shall not be counted as meetings to which such member was duly summoned. No Member of the Governing Body shall be present at a Meeting of the Governing Body
