ALDERSHOT DISTRICT ELECTRICITY (GODALMING
TRANSFER ETC.) SPECIAL ORDER, 1930.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Electricity Commissioners have submitted to the Minister of Transport for confirmation under the above-mentioned Acts a Special Order made by them for the supply by the Aldershot Gas Water and District Lighting Company of electricity within the Borough of Godalming and parts of the Parishes of Godalming Rural and Compton in the Rural District of Guildford in the County of Surrey.

The Minister of Transport proposes to confirm the Order and gives notice that any person affected who may be desirous of objecting to the confirmation of the same must, in accordance with the Electricity (Confirmation of Special Orders) Rules, 1921, do so by memorial addressed to the Minister of Transport written on one side only of foolscap paper and sent by registered post addressed to The Secretary, Ministry of Transport, 6, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W. 1, and posted not later than the 22nd day of September, 1930. A copy of any such memorial must also be sent in like manner to Messrs. Blyth Dutton Hartley and Blyth, 112, Gresham House, Old Broad Street, London, E.C. 2, Solicitors and Parliamentary Agents for the Order. Such memorial must be sealed or signed by the person objecting or by some responsible and duly authorised person on his behalf, and must state the specific grounds of objection to the Order and the modifications desired.

A copy of the Order as submitted for confirmation has been deposited for public inspection with the Clerks of the Peace for the Counties of Southampton, Surrey and West Sussex at their respective Offices at Winchester, Kingston-on-Thames and Chichester, with

the Town Clerk of the Borough of Godalming at his Office, with the Clerks to the Urban District Councils of Farnborough, Fleet, Frimley and Camberley and Haslemere at their respective Offices and with the Clerks to the Rural District Councils of Alton, Basingstoke, Hartley Wintney, Petersfield, Farnham, Guildford, Hambledon and Midhurst at their respective Offices.
