## ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1930 (No. 7).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Contraction of Yorks (North Riding) Footand-Mouth Disease Infected Area.

1.—(1) The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1930 (No. 5) shall be read and have effect as if the Area described in the First Schedule to this Order were substituted for the Infected Area described in the Schedule to that Order.

(2) This Article shall come into operation on the fifth day of October, nineteen hundred

and thirty.

Further Contraction of Pirbright (Surrey) Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area.

2.—(1) The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1930 (No. 3) as amended by the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1930 (No. 6) shall be read and have effect as if the Area described in the Second Schedule to this Order were substituted for the Infected Area described in the First Schedule to the last mentioned Order.

(2) This Article shall come into operation on the seventh day of October, nineteen hundred and thinks

dred and thirty.

Release of Pirbright (Surrey) Infected Area from Restrictions.

3. The Area described in the Second Schedule to this Order shall cease to be an Infected Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1925, as from the fourteenth day of October, nineteen hundred and thirty.
