

(ii) Any vehicle which is being used for the conveyance of goods or merchandise to or from any house, building or other premises situate on or adjacent to the said highway; or

(iii) Any vehicle which is being used in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said highway, or the laying, alteration or repair in or near to the said highway of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or any telegraph or telephone wires, cables, posts or supports.

##### *Urban District of Whitstable.*

Lower Island Wall extending in a south-westerly direction from its junction with Nelson Road to a point approximately 460 yards from that junction.

#### ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 6TH OCTOBER, 1930.)

#### FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1930 (No. 8).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

##### *Further Contraction of Yorks (North Riding) Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area.*

1.—(1) The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1930 (No. 5) as amended by the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1930 (No. 7) shall be read

and have effect as if the Area described in the Schedule to this Order were substituted for the Infected Area described in the First Schedule to the last mentioned Order.

(2) This Article shall come into operation on the twelfth day of October, nineteen hundred and thirty.

##### *Release of Yorks (North Riding) Infected Area from Restrictions.*

2. The Area described in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be an Infected Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1925, as from the nineteenth day of October, nineteen hundred and thirty.

##### *Short Title.*

3. This Order may be cited as the FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1930 (No. 8).

An Area comprising:—

*In the county of the North Riding of  
Yorkshire.*

The parishes of Bilsdale Midcable, Bilsdale West and Laskill Pasture; so much of the parishes of Broughton and Ingleby Greenhow as lies to the south of the railway from Stokesley Station to Kildale; and so much of the parishes of Helmsley and Pockley as lies to the north of the footpath which leads from the Carlton Watercourse near Roppa Sands direct to Stork House across Helmsley Moor and Pockley Moor.
