HORSHAM ELECTRICITY (EXTENSION).

NOTICE is hereby given that application has been made to the Electricity Commissioners by the Horsham Urban District Council (hereinafter called "the Council") whose address is the Council Offices, North Street, Horsham, to amend the draft of a Special Order under the above name or short title for which application has been made to the said Commissioners by the Council under

the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1928, in the following respects:—

(1) To provide that the area of supply described in the First Schedule to the said draft Order shall include, in addition to the area described in that Schedule, the Parishes of Nuthurst and Rusper in the Rural District of Horsham; the Parish of Lower Beeding and the detached portion of the Parish of Crawley in the said Rural District except so much of such parishes as lies to the east of an imaginary line commencing at the south-western corner of Gasson Wood in the Parish of Ifield and running in a south-easterly direction in a straight line to the Lodge at the entrance to Buchan Hill on the road from Colgate to Pease Pottage, thence in an easterly direction along the said road to the boundary of the said detached portion of the Parish of Crawley and also the part of the Urban District of Horsham which was included therein by the Order of the County Council of West Sussex of the 23rd November, 1900, and confirmed by the County of West Sussex (Horsham Extension) Confirmation Order, 1901 (all of which are hereinafter referred to as "the added area").

(2) To authorise the Council to break up streets and parts of streets not repairable by the local authority and railways within the added area.

A copy of the draft Order as originally applied for (showing the amendments now proposed) and a copy of the map showing the added area and the streets in which it is proposed that electric lines shall be laid down within a specified time have been deposited for public inspection at the offices of the Clerk of the Peace for the Administrative County of West Sussex at Chichester, at the offices of the Council and at the offices of the Horsham Rural District Council at 9, Carfax, Horsham.

Printed copies of the draft Order originally applied for (showing the amendments now proposed) can be obtained at the price of two shillings each from Mr. J. Packham, The Post Office, Broadbridge Heath, Horsham, Mr. F. W. Freeman, The Post Office, Warnham, Horsham, and at the offices of the under-mentioned Parliamentary Agents.

Notice is hereby further given that any authority company body or person desirous of bringing before the Electricity Commissioners any objections respecting the application must do so by letter sent by registered post addressed to The Secretary, Electricity Commission, Savoy Court, Strand, London, W.C. 2, and despatched on or before the 28th day of October, 1930, and a copy of such Objections must at the same time be forwarded to the under-mentioned Clerk or Parliamentary Agents.
