

the place of landing to the Foreign Animals Quarantine Station described in the Second Schedule hereto; the said railway truck shall be cleansed and disinfected before and after such use in the manner prescribed by the Inspector.

(3) The animal shall be detained in the said Quarantine Station for a period of at least ten hours after landing.

(4) Whilst detained in the said Quarantine Station the animal shall be under the control of a Veterinary Inspector appointed by the Ministry.

(5) During such period of detention no other animals shall be moved into the said Quarantine Station, and the animal landed under this Order shall be kept separate from all other animals.

(6) In the event of contagious pleuro-pneumonia, foot-and-mouth disease, or cattle-plague being suspected or found to exist during the prescribed period of detention in the animal referred to in this Order, the Ministry shall cause it to be slaughtered, and no compensation shall be payable by the Ministry in respect of such animal.

(7) The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries may, if he thinks fit, cause the tuberculin or any other test to be applied to the animal landed under this Order.

Disinfection of Quarantine Station, Vessel, etc.

4. The Foreign Animals Quarantine Station described in the Second Schedule hereto, and the vessel from which the animal is landed and the fittings, dung, fodder, litter and other things used for or about the animal, shall be disinfected or disposed of in the manner prescribed by the Inspector of the Ministry.
