(a) In lieu of an equivalent part of a temporary grant of £50 per annum formerly payable to the United Benefice of Bozeat with Strixton.

(b) In substitution for a grant of £60 per annum towards the remuneration of an assistant curate, secured by an Instrument dated the 21st May, 1896.

(c) In this case a benefaction of £900 was paid over to the Commissioners in respect of which an annual payment of £40 10s. 0d. will be made to the Incumbent for the time being.

(d) In this case a benefaction of £295 was paid over to the Commissioners in respect of which an annual payment of £13 5s. 6d. will be made to the Incumbent for the time being.

(e) In lieu of temporary grants of like amount formerly payable to the Benefice of Pitcombe.

(f) In this case a benefaction of £100 was paid over to the Commissioners in respect of which an annual payment of £4 10s. 0d. will be made to the Incumbent for the time being.

(g) In this case a benefaction of £150 was paid over to the Commissioners in respect of which an annual payment of £6 15s. 0d. will be made to the Incumbent for the time being.

(h) In this case a benefaction of £250 was paid over to the Commissioners in respect of which an annual payment of £11 5s. 0d. will be made to the Incumbent for the time being.

(k) In this case a benefaction consisting of £1,180 £4 per cent. Funding Stock was transferred to the Commissioners, the dividends on which will be paid to the Incumbent for the time being.

(l) In lieu of a temporary grant of like amount hitherto payable to the Benefice.

(m) To meet a benefaction consisting of Local Loans £3 per cent. Stock value £4,500.

(n) Conditional on the performance of services at Stert to the satisfaction of the Bishop of Salisbury, and in lieu of a grant of £120 per annum hitherto payable towards the stipend of an Assistant Curate employed in the Parish.

(p) To cease on a transfer—as defined in the Benefices Act, 1898—of the patronage.

(q) Subject to variation or withdrawal at the discretion of the Commissioners in the event of the Benefice being hereafter united with another.

(r) In lieu of a temporary grant of £60 per annum hitherto payable towards the stipend of a fourth Assistant Curate employed in the Parish of St. Mark, North End, Portsea, under the authority of an Instrument dated the 13th October, 1927, and published in the London Gazette on the 25th October in the same year.

(s) In this case a benefaction was paid over by W. Ingham Whitaker, Esq., to the Commissioners and invested by them in £2,000 Local Loans £3 per cent. Stock the dividends on which will be paid to the Incumbent for the time being.

(t) The grant will be subject to variation or withdrawal at the discretion of the Commissioners in the event of any powers of the Union of Benefices Measure, 1923, as extended by the Pluralities Measure, 1930, in relation to Union or otherwise, being exercised in a manner to affect this Benefice.

(u) To cease on the date on which the benefit from the bequest of the late Reverend J. P. Haslam accrues to the living.

(v) To cease on the 25th March, 1951.

(w) In lieu of a temporary grant of £60 per annum hitherto payable towards the stipend of a third Assistant Curate employed in the Parish of St. Mark, North End, Portsea, under the authority of an Instrument dated the 13th October, 1927, and published in the London Gazette on the 25th October in the same year.
