

Road from its junction with the Basingstoke—Alresford road (B.3046) at Cliddesden via White Hill, Northgate Farm, and Ellisfield to the road junction about 650 yards south-east of Ellisfield Church thence north-east to its junction with the Basingstoke—Alton road (A.339) at Little Bushywarren Copse about 900 yards north-west of Herriard.

Road from its junction with the Turgis Green—Mattingley road east of Hartley House to its junction with the Flood's Farm—Topford's Farm—Lyde Green road near Topford's Farm.

Road from its junction with the Flood's Farm—Topford's Farm—Lyde Green road near Topford's Farm to its junction with the Hartley—Wespall—Rotherwick road at Lyde Green.

Road from its junction with the Monk Sherborne—Sherborne St. John road at Lower Farm to its junction with the Wootton St. Lawrence—Sherborne St. John road near Wootton St. Lawrence.

Road from its junction with the Bramley—Holly Cross—Stratfield Saye road at the Fair Oak Green cross roads, via Folly Farm to its junction with the Bramley Green—Sherfield upon Loddon road near Green Farm, Bramley Green.

Road from its junction with the Sherfield upon Loddon—Fair Oak Green road about 1,000 yards south-east of Fair Oak Green via Southend Farm and Ives's Farm to its junction with the Stratfield Saye—Stratfield Turgis road about 200 yards north-east of King's Farm.

Road from its junction with the Basingstoke—Winchester road (A.33) about 2,300 yards south-west of Down Grange Farm, Basingstoke, via Hatch Warren to its junction with the Alresford—Basingstoke road (B.3046) at Cliddesden.

Road from its junction with the Basingstoke—Winchester road (A.33) at Down Grange Cottages, to its junction with the last-specified road south-east of Hatch Warren Farm.

Road from its junction with the Basingstoke—Alton road (A.339) south-west of Hackwood House to its junction with the Cliddesden—Ellisfield road about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south-east of Cliddesden.

Road from its junction with the Basingstoke—Alresford road (B.3046) north-east of Manor Farm, Basingstoke, via Farleigh Wallop Village to its junction with the Cliddesden—Ellisfield road south-west of Northgate Farm.

Road from the four cross roads at Dummer Church to its junction with the Basingstoke—Alresford road (B.3046) east of Manor Farm.

Road from the road junction in Mapledurwell to its junction with the Basingstoke—Greywell road about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile east of the Hatch Inn, Basing.

Road from its junction with the Axford—Upton Grey road at the four cross roads, Weston Corbett, to its junction with the Tunworth—Upton Grey road at the four cross roads east of Tunworth Church.

Road from its junction with the Bramley—Pamber End road at Bramley Corner via Latchmore Green, Hains Farm and Three Ashes to Silchester, thence north-west to its junction with the Pamber End Little London—

Mortimer West End road about 530 yards south-east of Pond Farm, Mortimer West End.

Road from its junction with the Bramley—Stratfield Saye road about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile west of the Basingstoke—Reading Railway via Minchen's Farm and Clapper's Farm to its junction with the last-specified road near Silchester Church.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

Rural District of Basingstoke.

Road from its junction with the Ellisfield—Farleigh Wallop road about 350 yards north-west of Ellisfield Church via Upper Common, skirting eastern boundary of High Wood to its junction with the Axford—Weston Patrick road at Preston Oak Hills.

Rural District of Romsey.

Road known as Salisbury Lane from its junction with the Romsey—Over Wallop road (B.3084) 660 yards west of the "Dukes Head" P.H. via Roke Farm to the road junction at Round House 235 yards west of Daman Cottage.

Road known as Halterworth Lane from its junction with the Romsey—Southampton road (A.27) 1,160 yards west of milestone Romsey 2 Botley 10 to the road junction west of "Halterworth" 265 yards south of Halterworth Crossing.

Road known as Hatt Lane from its junction with the Romsey—Over Wallop road (B.3084) 500 yards north of Dunbridge Station to the road junction in Mottisfont 185 yards west of Mottisfont Rectory.

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 28TH OCTOBER, 1930.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Authorisation of Landing of Animals for Exceptional Purposes.

1. The landing of the animals described in the First Schedule hereto, which are intended for exceptional purposes, is hereby allowed subject to the provisions of Part II (Quarantine) of the Third Schedule to the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, and of the Foreign Animals (Quarantine) Order of 1896, and of this Order.

Definition of Quarantine Station.

2. The premises described in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby defined as a Foreign Animals Quarantine Station for the purpose of the detention of the animals described in the First Schedule hereto.

Examination before Landing.

3. No such animals as aforesaid shall be landed except with the licence granted by an Inspector of the Ministry, which licence shall not be granted unless and until the animals have been examined by a Veterinary Inspector
