(Supply of Electricity by the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Oswestry in part of the Rural District of Oswestry in the County of Salop.)

To authorise the Corporation to generate and distribute electricity for all public and private purposes within the added area; to confer upon the Corporation all the powers usually conferred on distributors of electricity, as defined by the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1928; to alter, vary or extinguish all rights and privileges which would or might interfere with any of the objects of the Order; and to confer all other rights and privileges necessary for carrying such objects into effect.

- 3. To extend and make applicable to the added area all or some of the provisions contained in the Oswestry Electric Lighting Order 1894 as amended by the Oswestry Electricity (Extension &c.) Order, 1928, and to apply such provisions to the undertaking authorised by the Order subject to such variations and exceptions as may be contained therein.
- 4. To authorise the Corporation to break up streets and parts of streets which are not repairable by the Local Authority and railways within the added area.
- 5. To exclude from incorporation some or all of the provisions contained in the schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act, 1899, or to incorporate the same with such modifications and exceptions as may be indicated in the Order.
