

of the said St. Clair George Alfred, Bishop of Salisbury (in testimony whereof he has signed this Scheme), do humbly recommend and propose to Your Majesty as follows, that is to say:—

"1. That the said Benefice of Hooke and the part of the said United Benefice of Toller Porcorum with Toller Fratrum which consists of the said Benefice of Toller Porcorum shall be permanently united together and form one Benefice with cure of souls under the style of 'The United Benefice of Toller Porcorum with Hooke' and that such United Benefice shall be included in and form part of the Rural Deanery of Bridport, but the Parishes of the said Benefices shall continue distinct in all respects.

"2. That the said Benefice of Compton Abbas West with Wynford Eagle and the part of the said United Benefice of Toller Porcorum with Toller Fratrum which consists of the said Benefice of Toller Fratrum shall be permanently united together and form one Benefice with cure of souls under the style of 'The United Benefice of Compton Abbas West with Wynford Eagle and Toller Fratrum' and that such United Benefice shall be included in and form part of the Rural Deanery of Abbotsbury, but the Parishes of the said Benefices shall continue distinct in all respects.

"3. That with the consents of the said Reginald Herbert White and William Hewitson (testified by their respectively signing this Scheme) if upon the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council affirming this Scheme the said Benefice of Hooke shall be vacant then the said unions shall forthwith take effect, but if upon that day the said Benefice of Hooke shall be full then the said unions shall take effect immediately upon the first vacation thereafter of the said Benefice of Hooke, and in either case the said Reginald Herbert White, if he is then Incumbent of the said United Benefice of Toller Porcorum with Toller Fratrum, shall be the first Incumbent of the United Benefice of Toller Porcorum with Hooke, and the said William Hewitson, if he is then Incumbent of the said Benefice of Compton Abbas West with Wynford Eagle shall be the first Incumbent of the United Benefice of Compton Abbas West with Wynford Eagle and Toller Fratrum.

"4. That upon the said unions taking effect (1) the Parsonage House at present belonging to the said United Benefice of Toller Porcorum with Toller Fratrum shall become and be the house of residence for the Incumbent of the United Benefice of Toller Porcorum with Hooke (2) pending the provision of a new Parsonage House more suitably situated for the Incumbent of the United Benefice the Parsonage House at present belonging to the said Benefice of Compton Abbas West with Wynford Eagle shall become and be the house of residence for the Incumbent of the United Benefice of Compton Abbas West with Wynford Eagle and Toller Fratrum and (3) so soon as conveniently may be the Parsonage House at present belonging to the said Benefice of Hooke and the site and appurtenances thereof and the grounds heretofore usually occupied and enjoyed therewith shall be sold and disposed of by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners,

at such time or times and in such manner in all respects as to us shall seem expedient, and that the net proceeds of such sale shall be held and invested by us for the benefit of the United Benefice of Toller Porcorum with Hooke.

"5. That after the said unions have taken effect the course and succession in which the respective Patrons shall present or nominate to the United Benefices from time to time as the same shall become vacant shall be as follows, that is to say, (a) that in every series of three successive turns of presentation or nomination to be made to the United Benefice of Toller Porcorum with Hooke after the unions the Patron of the said United Benefice of Toller Porcorum with Toller Fratrum shall have the first and the third turns, and the Patron of the said Benefice of Hooke shall have the second turn and (b) that in every series of three successive turns of presentation or nomination to be made to the United Benefice of Compton Abbas West with Wynford Eagle and Toller Fratrum after the unions the Patron of the said Benefice of Compton Abbas West with Wynford Eagle shall have the first and the third turns and the Patron of the said United Benefice of Toller Porcorum with Toller Fratrum shall have the second turn.

"6. That upon the unions taking effect the endowments of the said United Benefice of Toller Porcorum with Toller Fratrum shall be divided as follows, that is to say, (1) all those Tithe Rent-charges commuted at £37 arising within the Parish of Toller Fratrum and now or formerly payable to the Incumbent for the time being of the said United Benefice of Toller Porcorum with Toller Fratrum, together with all capital sums of money, stocks, securities and other property being or representing the proceeds of any sale, redemption or other conversion of all or any of such Tithe Rent-charges and (2) a sum of £592 14s. 1d. London County Council £3 10s. 0d. per cent. per annum Stock now held by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, on behalf of the said United Benefice of Toller Porcorum with Toller Fratrum, shall be transferred to the United Benefice of Compton Abbas West with Wynford Eagle and Toller Fratrum, and all other the endowments now belonging to the said United Benefice of Toller Porcorum with Toller Fratrum shall be transferred and annexed to the United Benefice of Toller Porcorum with Hooke.

"And provided also that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the said Measure, or of any other Measure of the National Assembly of the Church of England, or of any Act of Parliament."

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme have been duly published in accordance with the provisions of the said Union of Benefices Measure, 1923, and Notices have been transmitted to the persons or bodies entitled under the same Measure to receive Notice requiring any objections to such draft Scheme to be stated or transmitted in writing to the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners within the time prescribed in the Statutory Rules applicable to proceedings under the said Union of Benefices Measure, 1923:
