

MIDDLESEX COUNTY COUNCIL ACT, 1930.

In pursuance of the powers conferred on me by sub-section (3) of section 17 of the Middlesex County Council Act, 1930, I hereby prescribe the following rules with which a Council shall comply before making any byelaws under Part IV (Regulation of Street Trading) of the said Act.

Rules for publication etc. of Byelaws.

(1) Any notice of intention to apply for confirmation of any such byelaws given by a Council in accordance with the provisions of section 184 of the Public Health Act, 1875, shall state that any objections or representations which any person desires to make in relation to such byelaws should be addressed to the Under Secretary of State, Home Office, Whitehall, S.W.1.

(2) One month at least before applying for confirmation of any such byelaws a Council shall serve a notice in writing of their intention to apply for confirmation thereof on every recognised organisation representative of street traders in the { Borough / Urban District } and shall take all reasonable steps either by the distribution or the posting of notices in streets in which street trading is carried on to make their intention known to street traders who may be affected by the operation of such byelaws. Every such notice shall state that any objections or representations which any person desires to make in relation to such byelaws should be addressed to the Under Secretary of State, Home Office, Whitehall, S.W.1.

MIDDLESEX COUNTY COUNCIL ACT, 1930.

In pursuance of sub-section (3) of section 12 of the Middlesex County Council Act, 1930, I hereby prescribe the following form of licence to be used by the councils of boroughs and urban districts in the County of Middlesex under Part IV (Regulation of Street Trading) of the said Act.

Street Trader's Licence.

This licence authorizes the holder to trade solely in the articles, and in the manner, and at the places and times specified in the Schedule to the licence and is granted subject (1) to the provisions of any Order made by the Secretary of State under section 13 of the said Act and of any Byelaws made by the { Borough / Urban District } Council under section 17 of the said Act; (2) to compliance with the Shops Acts, 1912 to 1928, and any Act amending the same and to any Orders made thereunder; and (3) to any other statutory enactment which is in force for the time being.

The licence, unless sooner revoked, shall continue in force until.....
and on expiry or revocation shall be surrendered to the { Borough / Urban District } Council.
