

prevent the London General Omnibus Company, Limited, from using after 12 noon on that day for the purpose of plying for hire in any of the streets or parts thereof declared to be "restricted streets" by any Order made by the Minister of Transport under the aforesaid Section of the London Traffic Act, 1924, and forming part of any of the approved routes shown in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto, such number of omnibuses as is shown opposite to each such route respectively in Column

2 of the said Schedule in excess of the number of omnibuses which they may use in those streets or parts thereof under the said Regulations, provided that nothing herein contained shall be deemed to affect or derogate from the powers of the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis under the provisions of Section 52 of the Metropolitan Police Act, 1839, to give directions to constables for keeping order and for preventing any obstruction of the thoroughfares.

For the purposes of the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1928, and all Orders and Licences made or granted and issued thereunder, and any Local Act relating to the supply of electricity, the Electricity Commissioners approve of the construction and pattern of the meter (hereinafter described) for the measurement of electrical energy when supplied on the constant pressure, two wire, single phase, alternating current system, and known as the Siemens, Type A.C. 10 Single Phase Watthour Meter, rated sizes 3 and 5 amperes for voltages of 100 to 120 volts, and 200 to 250 volts, and 10 and 15 amperes for voltages of 100 to 130 volts, and 200 to 250 volts, at a frequency of 50 cycles per second.

Provided that the meter be constructed as described in the specification and drawings deposited at the National Physical Laboratory, Teddington, Middlesex, dated and numbered 23rd May, 1930, and 24th June, 1930, and No. 132, and be in accordance with one of the pattern meters Nos. 10914, 10943, 13833, 14639 and 16050, deposited at the National Physical Laboratory on the 23rd June, 1930, by or on behalf of Siemens Brothers and Company Limited, Woolwich, S.E. 18, and sealed by the National Physical Laboratory at the instance of the Electricity Commissioners.

The Electricity Commissioners further approve of the means provided for fixing meters of this description, and for connecting them with the service lines as described in the specification and drawings above referred to.
