NOTICE is hereby given that by an Order dated the 31st day of December, 1930, the Minister of Health has confirmed an Order made on the 3rd day of November, 1930, by the Urban District Council of Brierley Hill, in pursuance of Section 112 of the Public Health Act, 1875, as amended by Section 51 of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, declaring the trade, business or manufacture of a fish frier within the Urban District of Brierley Hill to be an offensive trade.

1882 TO 1928.**

**WEST MIDLANDS ELECTRICITY DISTRICT
ORDER, 1925.**

*Joint Authority: Representatives of Workers
in the Industry.*

THE Minister of Labour hereby gives notice that as soon as may be after the 6th day of February, 1931, she will designate to the West Midlands Joint Electricity Authority, in accordance with Section 2 (9) of Part I of the First Annex to the Schedule to the West Midlands Electricity District Order, 1925, the employees' organisations having members in the employment of authorised Undertakers in the District, in order that the organisations so designated may choose a representative of persons employed in connection with the supply of electricity in the District to be a member of the Joint Authority.

Any employees' organisation which is desirous of being considered by the Minister for designation under the said Section 2 (9) should make application in writing to the Minister not later than the 4th day of February, 1931, on the form provided for the purpose, of which copies may be obtained from the Secretary, Ministry of Labour, Montagu House, Whitehall, London, S.W. 1.
