NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACTS, 1924 TO 1928, AND NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1924 TO 1930.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health, the Department of Health for Scotland, and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, with the approval of the Treasury and of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the National Health Insurance Acts, 1924 to 1928, and the National Health Insurance Acts (Northern Ireland), 1924 to 1930, to make Regulations to amend the National Health Insurance (Approved Societies) Regulations, 1930;

And that on account of urgency the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made Regulations entitled the National Health Insurance (Approved Societies) Amendment Regulations, 1930, to come into force immediately as provisional regulations to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act;
