ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 28TH JANUARY, 1931.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Cessation of landing in Great Britain of Animals from the Port of Newry, Northern Ireland.

The Animals (Landing from Ireland, Channel Islands and Isle of Man) Order of 1923, shall be read and have effect as if the Port of Newry was excluded from the list set out in the First Schedule to that Order of Ports in Ireland from which Animals may be brought to Landing Places in Great Britain.

In witness whereof the Official Seal of the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries is hereunto affixed this twenty-eighth day of January, nineteen hundred and thirty-one.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACT, 1925.

BY an Order dated the 12th day of January, 1931, the Minister of Health has declared that, on and after the 16th day of February, 1931, section 95 of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907 (which relates to the purchase and appropriation of lands), shall be in force in the Urban District of Lye and Wollescote.
