MANCHESTER IMPORTED ANIMALS WHARF ORDER OF 1931.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Definition of Imported Animals Wharf.

1. The premises described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby defined as an Imported Animals Wharf for the purposes of the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and any Order of the Minister thereunder.

Revocation of certain Order.

2. The Manchester Imported Animals Wharf Order of 1930 (No. 2) is hereby revoked.

Short Title.

3. This Order may be cited as the MANCHESTER IMPORTED ANIMALS WHARF ORDER OF 1931.

PUBLIC WORKS FACILITIES ACT, 1930.

NOTTINGHAM CORPORATION (WATER) SCHEME.

NOTICE is hereby given that application has been made by the Lord Mayor Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Nottingham and county of the same city (hereinafter called "the Corporation" and "the city" respectively) to the Minister of Health for a scheme (hereinafter called "the scheme") under Section 1 of the Public Works Facilities Act, 1930, of which scheme the principal subject matters are:—

1. The construction and maintenance of the following waterworks in the county of Nottingham:—

Waterwork No. 1.—An aqueduct, conduit or line or lines of pipes in the Urban District of Eastwood, and the Parishes of Brinsley, Selston and Annesley, in the Rural District of Basford.

Waterwork No. 2.—A boosting pumping station in the said Parish of Selston.

Waterwork No. 3.—An aqueduct, conduit or line or lines of pipes in the Parish of South Wilford in the Rural District of Basford, and the Parishes of Edwalton, Plumtree, Normanton-on-the-Wolds, Keyworth, and Stanton-on-the-Wolds, in the Rural District of Bingham.

Waterwork No. 4.—A boosting pumping station in the said Parish of Normanton-on-the-Wolds.

Waterwork No. 5.—An elevated water tank in the said Parish of Stanton-on-the-Wolds.
