

2. The acquisition of lands for the purposes of the proposed waterworks; and the modification of the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845, as to "parts only" of certain properties.

3. The extension of the limits of the Corporation for the supply of water so as to include therein the following parishes or townships in the county of Nottingham:—

(a) Bradmore, Bunny, Cossall, Ruddington, Strelley, Annesley, Barton-in-Fabis, Bilborough, Calverton, Clifton-with-Glapton, Felley, Gamston, Gotham, Lambley, Newstead, Selston, Thrumpton, Trowell and Woodborough in the rural district of Basford;

(b) Aslockton, Bingham, Car Colston, Clipston, Colston Basset, Cotgrave, Cropwell Bishop, Cropwell Butler, East Bridgford, Elton, Flawborough, Flintham, Granby, Hawksworth, Hickling, Holme Pierrepont, Keyworth, Kinoulton, Kneeton, Langar-cum-Barnstone, Normanton-on-the-Wolds, Orston, Owthorpe, Plumtree, Saxondale, Scarrington, Screveton, Shelford, Shelton, Sibthorpe, Stanton-on-the-Wolds, Thoroton, Tollerton, Tythby, Upper Broughton, Whatton, Widmerpool and Wiverton Hall in the rural district of Bingham.

4. The termination of agreements between the Corporation and the Basford and Bingham Rural District Councils with respect to the supply of water to premises or property within their respective districts and provision as to the cessation of supply by the said Councils in the county of Nottingham.

5. The purchase by the Corporation of water mains plant meters fittings and apparatus of the Basford Rural District Council in the parishes of Annesley, Bradmore, Bunny, Cossall, Gotham, Kirkby-in-Ashfield, Ruddington and Selston in the rural district of Basford in the said county.

6. Authority for the Corporation to borrow money for the construction of the proposed waterworks and for other purposes and the enactment of all necessary financial and miscellaneous provisions.

7. The incorporation, repeal and amendment of Acts.

Plans and sections of the proposed works and plans of the lands intended to be taken for the purposes of the intended scheme, together with a book of reference to the plans, were on the 9th day of February, 1931, deposited with the Clerk of the County Council of the Administrative County of Nottingham at his office at the Shire Hall, Nottingham, and a copy of so much of the said plans, sections and book of reference as relates to each of the several areas hereinafter mentioned were on the said 9th day of February deposited for public inspection with the officers hereinafter mentioned (that is to say):—

The Urban District of Eastwood, with the Clerk to the Eastwood Urban District Council at his office at 10, Market Street, Heanor;

The Rural District of Basford, with the Clerk to the Basford Rural District Council at his office at Rock House, Basford, Nottingham;

The Rural District of Bingham, with the Clerk to the Bingham Rural District Council at his office at Bingham;

The Parish of Annesley, with the Clerk to the Parish Council of that parish at his office at Annesley, Notts;

The Parish of Brinsley, with the Clerk to the Parish Council of that parish at his office at Sunnyside, Broad Lane, Brinsley;

The Parish of Keyworth, with the Clerk to the Parish Council of that parish at his office at Keyworth;

The Parish of Selston, with the Clerk to the Parish Council of that parish at his office at the Council Offices, Selston;

The Parish of South Wilford, with the Clerk to the Parish Council of that parish at his office at School House, South Wilford;

The Parish of Edwalton, with the Chairman of the Parish Meeting of that parish at his residence at The Rectory, Edwalton;

The Parish of Normanton-on-the-Wolds, with the Chairman of the Parish Meeting of that parish at his residence at Normanton-on-the-Wolds;

The Parish of Plumtree, with the Chairman of the Parish Meeting of that parish at his residence at Plumtree;

The Parish of Stanton-on-the-Wolds, with the Chairman of the Parish Meeting of that parish at his residence at Stanton-on-the-Wolds.

Copies of the scheme, plans, sections, book of reference and estimate of expense may be inspected and copies thereof respectively may be made or purchased (at the price of two shillings for each copy as regards the scheme) at the Office of the undersigned Town Clerk in the Guildhall, Nottingham, and copies of the scheme may be inspected and obtained at the offices of the undersigned Parliamentary Agents at all reasonable times.

Any objections respecting the scheme or to any proposals in the scheme may be made in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Health, Whitehall, S.W. 1, on or before the 7th day of March, 1931, and copies of such objections must at the same time be sent to the undersigned Town Clerk or Parliamentary Agents.

A full notice stating the objects of the scheme has been or will be published in the Nottingham Guardian of the 10th and 17th days of February instant, and in the Nottingham Journal of the same dates.
