The following Statute made by the University of Oxford, on the 17th day of February, 1931, has been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923."

UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD.

STATUTE APPROVED BY CONGREGATION ON
TUESDAY, 17TH FEBRUARY, 1931.

Whereas it is expedient to provide that the emoluments of vacant Professorships shall be paid to the Common University Fund: Now THE UNIVERSITY in exercise of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923, and of all other powers enabling it, ENACTS, subject to the approval of His Majesty in Council, AS FOLLOWS.

In Statt. Tit. IV. Sect. i. § 2 (a), cl.^o 4 (*Statuta*, ed. 1930, p. 55), the words "office; and the emoluments of it accruing during that period" shall be struck out, and the words "office. 5. The emoluments of a Professorship during a vacancy or period of suspension" shall be substituted.

TENDERS FOR TREASURY BILLS.

1. The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Chief Cashier's Office, at the Bank of England, on Friday, the 6th March, 1931, at 1 o'clock, for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act, 1877, the National Debt Act, 1889, and the War Loan Acts, 1914-1919, to the amount of £30,000,000.

2. The Bills will be in amounts of £5,000 or £10,000. They will be dated at the option of the Tenderer on any business day from Monday, the 9th March, 1931, to Saturday, the 14th March, 1931, inclusive, and will be payable at three months after date.

3. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.
