

tive Parishes and in case you shall on full consideration and enquiry be satisfied therewith I request that your Grace will be pleased to certify the same and the Consents of the said respective Patrons and Incumbents thereto to His Majesty in Council."

And whereas the said Scheme drawn up by the said Bishop and the Consents referred to in the said Representation are as follows:—

"SCHEME.

"1. It is proposed to separate the following District from the Ecclesiastical Parish of Tooting Graveney, in the County of Surrey and Diocese of Southwark, and unite the same for Ecclesiastical purposes to the adjoining Parish of St. Mary, Summerstown.

"Such District shall consist of that portion of the said Ecclesiastical Parish of Tooting Graveney which is bounded on the north west by the said Ecclesiastical Parish of St. Mary, Summerstown, on the north east by the Ecclesiastical District of St. Augustine, Tooting, on the south west by an imaginary line running along the centre of Blackshaw Road and on the south east by an imaginary line commencing from a point in the centre of Blackshaw Road aforesaid opposite the north western boundary wall of the Grove Hospital and proceeds in a north easterly direction to the said north western boundary wall along such boundary wall and continues in the same direction across Tooting Groove and along the north western boundary wall of Tooting Garden and the south eastern boundary wall of the Fountain Public House until it reaches the south western boundary of the said Ecclesiastical District of St. Augustine, Tooting, in the centre of Garratt Lane.

"Such District is coloured pink on the plan annexed hereto and thereon indicated by the letter 'A.'

"2. It is also proposed to separate the following District from the said Ecclesiastical Parish of Tooting Graveney and unite the same for Ecclesiastical purposes to the adjoining Ecclesiastical Parish of Christ Church, Mitcham.

"Such District shall consist of that portion of the said Ecclesiastical Parish of Tooting Graveney which lies to the south of an imaginary line running along the centre of the Tooting Merton and Wimbledon Branch of the Southern Railway running between Haydons Road Station and Tooting Junction Station which contains inter alia the Tooting and Merton Brick Works portions and Boundary Road and the houses fronting thereon and of Briscoe Road and also Acre Road.

"Such District is coloured pink on the plan annexed hereto and thereon indicated by the letter 'B.'

"3. It is also proposed to separate the following District from the said Ecclesiastical Parish of Tooting Graveney and unite the same for Ecclesiastical purposes to the said adjoining Ecclesiastical Parish of Christ Church, Mitcham.

"Such District shall consist of that portion of the said Ecclesiastical Parish of Tooting Graveney which is bounded on the north by an imaginary line running along the centre of the Tooting Merton and Wimbledon Branch

of the Southern Railway running between Haydons Road and Tooting Junction Stations on the south or south east by an imaginary line running along the centre of the said Railway running between Merton Abbey and Tooting Junction Stations and on the south west by the said Ecclesiastical Parish of Christ Church, Mitcham.

"Such District is coloured pink on the plan annexed hereto and indicated by the letter 'C.'

"4. It is also proposed to separate the following District from the said Ecclesiastical Parish of Tooting Graveney and unite the same for Ecclesiastical purposes to the adjoining Ecclesiastical Parish of St. Barnabas, Mitcham.

"Such District shall consist of that portion of the said Ecclesiastical Parish of Tooting Graveney which is bounded on the north or north west by the District referred to in clause 3 hereof on the south west by the said Ecclesiastical Parish of Christ Church, Mitcham, and on the south east partly by the said Ecclesiastical Parish of Christ Church, Mitcham, and partly by the said Ecclesiastical Parish of St. Barnabas, Mitcham.

"Such District is coloured pink on the plan annexed hereto and thereon hatched red and indicated by the letter 'D.'

"5. It is also proposed to separate the following three Districts from the said Ecclesiastical Parish of Christ Church, Mitcham, and unite the same for Ecclesiastical purposes to the adjoining Ecclesiastical Parish of Tooting Graveney aforesaid.

"Such Districts shall consist of all those portions of the said Ecclesiastical Parish of Christ Church, Mitcham, which lie to the north of an imaginary line running along the centre of the hereinbefore mentioned Railway running between Haydons Road and Tooting Junction Stations.

"Such Districts are coloured green on the plan annexed hereto and therein indicated by the letters 'E', 'F' and 'G' respectively.

"6. It is also proposed to separate the following District from the Ecclesiastical Parish of Christ Church, Mitcham, aforesaid and unite the same for Ecclesiastical purposes to the adjoining Ecclesiastical Parish of St. Barnabas, Mitcham, aforesaid.

"Such District shall consist of that portion of the said Ecclesiastical Parish of Christ Church, Mitcham which is bounded on the north west by an imaginary line running along the centre of the said Railway running between Merton Abbey and Tooting Junction Stations on the north east by the District referred to in clause 4 hereof on the east by the said Ecclesiastical parish of St. Barnabas, Mitcham, and on the south and east by an imaginary line commencing at the point where the boundaries of the Ecclesiastical Parishes of Christ Church, Mitcham, St. Barnabas, Mitcham, and St. Mark, Mitcham, meet in the centre of London Road and proceeds in a south easterly direction along the boundary between the said Ecclesiastical Parishes of Christ Church, Mitcham, and St. Mark, Mitcham, until it reaches the centre of the new Road called Victoria Road whence it proceeds in a westerly or south westerly direction along the centre of the last mentioned Road until it reaches a
